Worshiping in Spirit and in Truth *John 4:19-24*

I. The Distraction of True Worship (v 19-20)

- A. The Samaritan woman gives <u>respect</u> without true <u>understanding.</u> (v 19)
- B. Worship is rightly <u>defined</u> but improperly <u>done</u>. (v 20)
- **1.** Worship defined: to prostrate one's self in homage, to revere to adore .
- **2.** Her understanding of worship is convoluted by inconsequential <u>controversy</u>.

II. Worship turned Upside Down (v 21-22)

- **A.** Worship is not an empty <u>ritual</u> or ceremony (v 21)
- **B.** Worship is <u>centered</u> upon Jesus. (v 22)

III. Worship that God Requires (v 23-24)

- A. An Already-But-Not-Yet Reality to Worship (v 23)
- B. True worshipers worship in spirit and in Truth
- **1.** Spirit: the spirit that dwells within us; from the heart.
- **2.** Truth: the Word of God
