## THE GLORY OF THE CROSS

- I. THE DOCTRINE OF THE CROSS (vv. 11-13)—the cross of Christ (v. 12)
  - A. The Cross is the Means of Salvation—knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ (2:16)
  - B. The Cross is the Means of Sanctification—I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me (2:20)
- II. THE DESIGN OF THE CROSS (14-16)
  - A. An Upward Acclamation—But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ (v, 14a)
  - B. A Clear Distinction—by whom [which] the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world (v. 14b)
  - C. A New Creation—For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision not uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation (v. 15)
  - D. A Godly Nation—the Israel of God (v. 16)
- III. THE DIFFICULTY OF THE CROSS (vv. 17-18)
  - A. Social Rejection—let no one trouble me...
  - B. Physical Persecution—I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus
