

YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN!

*Luke 15:11-32*

- I. THE SON'S REBELLION AGAINST THE FATHER (vv. 11-16)—*journeyed to a far country...*
  - A. Leads to a Life of Depravity (vv. 11-14)—*wasted his possessions with prodigal living...*
  - B. Leads to a Life of Disgrace (vv. 15-16)—*to feed swine...*
- II. THE SINNER'S REALIZATION ABOUT THE FATHER (vv. 17-19)—*But when he came to himself...*
  - A. His Hopelessness without the Father (v. 17)—*I perish...*
  - B. His Unworthiness before the Father (vv. 18-19)—*I have sinned against heaven...am no longer worthy to be called your son.*
- III. THE FATHER'S RECEPTION OF THE PRODIGAL (vv. 20-24)—*his father saw him, ran...and kissed him...*
  - A. He Received Him with Compassion (v. 20)—*had compassion...*
  - B. He Received Him with Celebration (vv. 21-24)—*Bring out the best...and let us eat and be merry*
- IV. THE BROTHER'S REJECTION OF THE FATHER (vv. 25-32)—*But he was angry...*
  - A. He Rejected the Father's Grace (vv. 25-30)—*I have been serving you...and yet you never gave me...*

- B. He Rejected the Father's Values (vv. 31-32)—*It was right that we should make merry and be glad...*
