

TEMPTED AND TRIED
Hebrews 2:10-18

“He Himself has suffered, being tempted...” (v. 18)

The divine Son of God became a real man and suffered on the Cross so that He could accomplish:

I. VINDICATION OF GOD’S PERSON (v. 10)

“It was fitting for Him...to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.”

A. His Justice is Completely Satisfied—*For it was fitting for Him*

B. His Love is Graciously Applied—*bringing many sons to glory*

II. IDENTIFICATION WITH GOD’S PEOPLE (vv. 11-16)

A. Only a Human Savior Can Save Us from Sin’s Penalty (vv. 11-13)—*He who sanctifies...*

B. Only a Human Savior Can Save Us from Sin’s Power (vv. 14-16)—*that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death...*

III. ADMINISTRATION OF GOD’S PLAN (vv. 17-18)

A. The Demonstration of the Love of God toward Sinners (v. 17-18)—*a merciful and faithful High Priest*

B. The Satisfaction of the Wrath of God against Sinners (v. 17)—*to make propitiation for the sins of the people*
