- B. The Deception of False Glory (v. 19b)—Behold, it is overlaid with gold and silver, Yet in it there is no breath at all.

III. THE CONTRAST TO IDOLATRY (v. 20)

- A. His Sovereignty (v. 20a)—But the LORD is in His holy temple.
- B. His Authority (v. 20b)—Let all the earth keep silent before Him.
