- I. THE PREACHING OF THE GOSPEL (vv. 1-2)
 - A. It is Proclaimed by His Servants (v.1)—set apart for the gospel of God
 - B. It is Promised in the Scriptures (v. 2)—which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures...
- II. THE PERSON OF THE GOSPEL (vv. 3-4)—concerning his Son...Jesus Christ our Lord.
 - A. Jesus' Humanity is Indicated (v. 3)—was descended from David, according to the flesh...
 - B. Jesus' Deity is Validated (v. 4)—and was declared to be the Son of God in power...by his resurrection from the dead...
- III. THE PURPOSE OF THE GOSPEL (vv. 5-7)
 - A. To Save Sinners (vv. 5-7)—to bring about the obedience of faith...among all nations...
 - 1. God's Call to Submission (v. 5)—the obedience of faith...
 - 2. God's Call to Possession (v. 6)—to belong to Jesus Christ...
 - 3. God's Call to Distinction (v. 7)—to be saints
 - B. To Celebrate the Savior (v. 5)—for the sake of his name
