

HE IS LORD OF ALL
Luke 24:36-53

I. HIS UNDENIABLE RESURRECTION (vv. 36-43)

A. The Superiority of His Present Body (v. 36)—*Jesus himself stood among them...*

B. The Continuity with His Previous Body (vv. 37-43)—*it is I myself. Touch me and see* (v. 39)

1. Identity—*it is I myself* (v. 39)

2. Tangibility—*Touch me and see.* (v. 39)

3. Activity—*They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate it before them* (vv. 42-43)

II. HIS UNCHANGABLE MISSION (vv. 44-49)

A. His Substitutionary Atonement (vv. 44-46)—*Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer...* (v. 46)

B. His Saving Announcement (vv. 47-49)—*and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations...*(v. 47)

III. HIS UNRIVALED EXALTATION (vv. 50-53)

A. The Coronation in Heaven (vv. 50-51)—*he parted from them and was carried up into heaven* (v. 51)

B. The Celebration on Earth (vv. 52-53)—*And they worshiped him and returned to Jerusalem with great joy...*(v. 52)
