Romans 3:21-26

- I. THE MANIFESTATION OF RIGHTEOUSNESS THROUGH CHRIST (v. 21)
  - A. The Law Does Not Provide Righteousness—*But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law...*
  - B. The Law Does Point to Righteousness—*although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it...*
- II. THE APPROPRIATION OF RIGHTEOUSNESS THROUGH FAITH (v. 22)
  - A. Saving Faith Has One Object—*through faith in Jesus Christ*
  - B. Saving Faith is The Way for All—*for all who believe: For there is no distinction...*
- III. THE PROCLAMATION OF RIGHTEOUSNESS BY GRACE (vv. 23-24a)
  - A. The Hopeless Condition of Man (v. 23)—*All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...*
  - B. The Matchless Contribution from God (v. 24a)—*and are justified by his grace as a gift...*
- IV. THE PROVISION OF RIGHTEOUSNESS BY GOD (vv. 24b-26)
  - A. God's Redemption (v. 24c)—*through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus...*
  - B. God's Propitiation (v. 25)—*whom God put forward as a propitiation...*
  - C. God's Justification (v. 26)—*that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.*
