WHOM GOD COUNTS AS RIGHTEOUS Romans 4:1-8

- I. WHAT ABRAHAM DISCOVERED (vv. 1-3)
 - A. Abraham's Failure to Gain Righteousness—but not before God (vv. 1-2)
 - B. Abraham's Faith Received Righteousness—Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness (v. 3)
- II. WHAT LOGIC DEMANDS (vv. 4-5)
 - A. Righteousness by Human Effort is Deficient (v. 4)—Now to the one who works...
 - B. Righteousness through Faith in Christ is Sufficient (v. 5)—And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly...
- III. WHAT SCRIPTURE DECLARES (vv. 6-8)
 - A. The Blessing of Expiation through Faith in Christ (vv. 6-7)—whose sins are covered
 - B. The Blessing of Justification through Faith in Christ (v. 8)—against whom the Lord will not count his sins
