- I. THE EXPLANATION OF THE CHRISTIAN'S HOPE (vv. 1-2a)
 - A. The Basis of Our Hopeful Status (v. 1a)—Therefore, since we have been justified by faith...
 - B. The Benefits of Our Hopeful Status—(vv. 1b-2a)—we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand...
- II. THE EXPRESSION OF THE CHRISTIAN'S HOPE (vv. 2b-4)
 - A. We Rejoice in The Future State (v. 2b)—and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
 - B. We Rejoice in The Present Circumstances (vv. 3-4)—Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings...
- III. THE EXPERIENCE OF THE CHRISTIAN'S HOPE (v. 5)
 - A. The Presence of His Love Assures Us.—and hope does not put to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts...
 - B. The Person of His Spirit Assists Us—through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.
