Blessed is the man Psalm 112:1-10

Praise the Lord! Blessed is the man who fears the Lord, who greatly delights in his commandments! His offspring will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed. Wealth and riches are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever. Light dawns in the darkness for the upright; he is gracious, merciful, and righteous. It is well with the man who deals generously and lends; who conducts his affairs with justice. For the righteous will never be moved; he will be remembered forever. He is not afraid of bad news; his heart is firm, trusting in the Lord. His heart is steady; he will not be afraid, until he looks in triumph on his adversaries. He has distributed freely; he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever; his horn is exalted in honor. The wicked man sees it and is angry; he gnashes his teeth and melts away; the desire of the wicked will perish!

I. The main attributes of a blessed man (112:1)

- **A.** A man who fears the Lord (Psalm 112:1)... "Blessed is the man who fears the Lord."
- **B**. A man who loves the Lord (Psalm 112:1)... Blessed is the man who fears the Lord, who **greatly delights** in his commandments!
- **C.** A man who loves the Word (Psalm 112:1)... Blessed is the man who fears the Lord, who greatly delights in <u>his commandments!</u>

II. The result of a blessed man (112:2-4)

- **A.** God provides him with a lasting legacy (Psalm 112:2)... His <u>offspring</u> will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed.
- **B.** God supplies for his needs (Psalm 112:3)... <u>Wealth</u> and <u>riches</u> are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.
- **C.** God supplies Goodness & Godliness for the blessed man (Psalm 112:4)... Light dawns in the darkness for the upright; he is gracious, merciful, and righteous.

III. The Unique Qualities of a Blessed Man (112:5-8)

- **A.** He is Considerate with people (Psalm 112:5)... It is well with the man who deals generously and lends; who conducts his affairs with justice.
- **B.** He is Vigilant with dealings (Psalm 112:5)... It is well with the man who deals generously and lends; who conducts his affairs with justice.
- **C.** He is Confident of His Faith and Future (112:6-8)... For the righteous will never be moved; he will be remembered forever. He is not afraid of bad news; his heart is firm, trusting in the Lord. His heart is steady; he will not be afraid, until he looks in triumph on his adversaries.
